



**Zero HIV Stigma Day is July 21** and is a joint initiative of NAZ and IAPAC, in collaboration with the **Global HIV Collaborative** and **Fast-Track Cities Institute**. **HIV stigma** refers to irrational or negative attitudes, behaviors, and judgments towards people living with or at risk of HIV.

Zero Stigma Day **represents a movement to unite people, communities, and countries to help raise awareness about HIV stigma and learn about ways to help stop it.** This observance is also in honor of Prudence Mabele, the first Black South African woman to publicly share her HIV status.
