An avid nature enthusiast, Dr. Whiteside also plans to travel across the country and around the world, engaging in birding and butterflying.

To honor Dr. Whiteside's prestigious career the City of Key West proclaimed November 14, 2024, to be Dr. Whiteside Day.

Monroe County Board of County Commissioners proclaimed November 19, 2024, to be Dr. Mark Whiteside Day and presented him with an Honorary Conch Certificate on that date.
