Monroe, Fla. — The Florida Department of Health in Monroe County (DOH-Monroe) is lifting the advisory for high bacterial levels the following location:

**John Pennekamp State Park Beach
Key Largo, FL 33037**

Tests completed on Thursday, May 22, 2025, indicate that the water quality at John Pennekamp State Park Beach shows an acceptable level of *Enterococcus* bacteria established by state guidelines. Test results are available at FloridaHealth.gov/HealthyBeaches.
