Micro-Mobility Device Safety

- **Motorists have a difficult time spotting you, make yourself visible**
- **Signal your movements—don't assume other drivers know what you are doing!**
- **Front and Rear Lights must be used at night.**

- **Operators must alert when passing**
- **NOT Permitted on sidewalks***

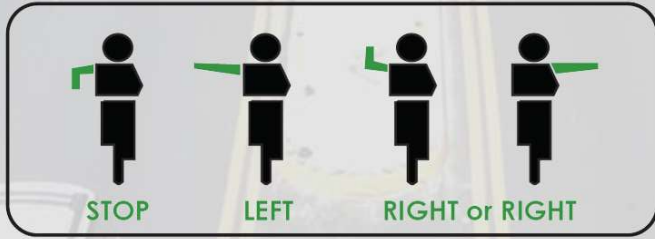


- **Permitted on Multi-Use paths at speeds not exceeding 15 mph.**

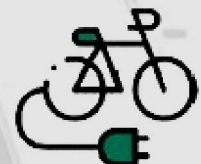

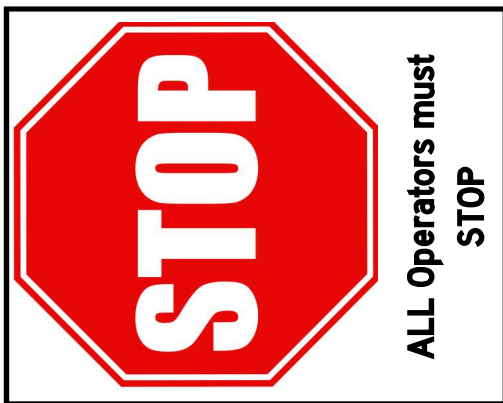

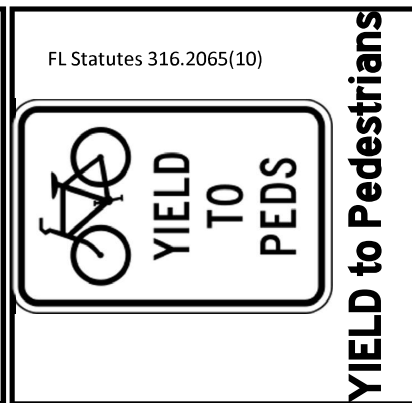


Multi-use paths available for electric bike use are as follows:

FL Statutes 316.2065(10)

Micro-Mobility

Device:

Any motorized transportation device made available for private use by reservation, which is not capable of traveling at a speed greater than 20 MPH on level ground.

FL Statutes 316.003(48)
